### An International event

Now in its sixth edition, the Adriatic Sea Forum is an international itinerant event conceived by Risposte Turismo – research and consulting company, operating within the tourism macro-industry, founded and led by Francesco di Cesare - and dedicated to maritime tourism in the Adriatic Sea.

#### **Countries involved**

The event is an occasion for meetings, discussions and in-depth analysis among all those that deal with or have an interest in the maritime tourism market (shipping companies, cruise and ferry terminals, marinas and ports, maritime agencies, tour operators, travel agencies, charter companies, shipyards, public administration, local tourism boards) and for all those who want to get a better insight into the characteristics and the dynamics involved.

#### The format

The Adriatic Sea Forum consists of meetings, debates and business network opportunities during which all participants will have the opportunity to improve their knowledge, to create new relationships and strengthen the existing ones, and to promote their own activities and projects.

Over 200 operators - including entrepreneurs, managers, figures from the public administration, researchers and representatives of the European projects - took part in each edition, making an active contribution to the discussions and debates, as well as developing new business relationships.

#### **Date and location**

The 2023 edition of the Adriatic Sea Forum, organized partnership with Port Authority. Dubrovnik took place in Dubrovnik on Thursday the 4th and Friday the 5th of May at the **Royal Princess Conference** Centre.



#### The summit

The big news of the sixth edition of the Adriatic Sea Forum was the first Summit of the Presidents of the Adriatic ports of call and trade associations, about cross-cutting and common themes in the Adriatic area, such as the increase of the cruise and ferry traffic, the management of passengers by sea and new initiatives to reduce environmental impact.

The summit is the result of the joint efforts of Risposte Turismo - the company that conceived and organized the forum -, Italian Ports Association and the Association of Croatian Port Authorities, the Summit in program took place behind closed doors, a unique and never-before held meeting in the Adriatic area.

The meeting ended with the signing of a declaration of intent on future initiatives and activities that can be implemented in the tourist ports of call of the countries flanking the Adriatic Sea.

#### **Themest**

The event is dedicated to the analysis of numerous topics of interest for the cruise, ferry and nautical markets in the Adriatic area. Among them: the course of the tourist flows by sea, the developments and the perspectives of the market with a focus on sustainability, mobility and infrastructures, the challenges of the local operators in a sector populated by large multinational companies and the investments planned for the coming years.

The forum provides a series of round tables, opportunities for discussion and debate for representatives of the major companies in the sector and individual interventions by market experts dedicated to the deepening of the topics scheduled.



#### **Themest**

2023 edition's programme gave space to the new session "What's new in Adriatic" where some news, for the near future and for a closing focus dedicated to sea tourism in Croatia, has been presented, with the objectives to be achieved in the coming years in the light of the numerous development projects in progress or recently completed.

# **Adriatic Sea Tourism Report**

In the Forum's opening phase, the new edition of the Adriatic Sea Tourism Report has been presented. The research report is conducted by Risposte Turismo since 2013, and analyses the flows, dimensions, nature and directions of tourist sea movements (cruise, ferry and nautical sector).

#### The partner

The sixth edition of the Adriatic Sea Forum has been organized in partnership with the Dubrovnik Port Authority and the City of Dubrovnik.

Dubrovnik Port Authority was founded by the Croatian Government with the aim of controlling, building and managing the port of Dubrovnik -Gruž. Open to international public transport, it was proclaimed by the Republic of Croatia a port of international and economic interest because of its size and importance.



The Port Authority deals, among other activities, with the management of the maritime domain related to the port area and the construction, maintenance and improvement of the substructures of the port, The agency, moreover, releases concessions as a result of public contest and coordinates, supervises the concessionary activities that have place in the harbour area. At last, deliberates on the management of the zone of free port situated inside the harbour pertinences.

#### **City of Dubrovnik**

Dubrovnik is situated in the Adriatic Sea, in the most southeastern part of Croatia. The city is usually regarded as the most picturesque city on the Croatian coast and is referred to as the "Pearl of the Adriatic". Dubrovnik is probably best known for its walls built between the 12th and 17th centuries which nowadays attract tourists from all over the world and always stands proudly on the list of the most desirable destination to visit. The old city of Dubrovnik was designated a UNESCO World Heritage site in 1979. Dubrovnik is a city that charms with its cultural scene, festivals, open air concerts, as well as concerts in historic venues, gardens and hosts many international conferences and events.

# The location: **Royal Princess** Conference Center

A stone's throw from the sea and located just minutes from the historic center of Dubrovnik, the world-famous UNESCO site, the Royal Hotels and Resorts hosted the 6th edition of the international itinerant forum dedicated maritime tourism in the Adriatic Sea.
